Complete your online registration by clicking on the registration link of your desired course into your browser. You may receive additional hours of college credit for this course if you choose to apply it in your classroom and show impact (you have up to a year to complete all five components, parts 2-5)! **You also have the choice of ONLY requesting credit for attending the workshop and completing the reflection paper, part one. Note: Part 1 is required, 2-5 are optional for additional credit, but they must be taken sequentially.**

You must register and submit your assignment within 7 following the date of your workshop. Registration is open NOW until 4/29/2022 at 11:59 PM.
